## ACCA RECOGNITION OF BACTA: EIGHT EXEMPTIONS OUT OF NINE!

We are glad to share with you the news that on January 13, 2020, BCB received official confirmation from the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) that, starting from 2019, BACTA graduates will be eligible to claim as much as 8 ACCA exemptions out of the possible 9, subject to the graduates' successful completion of corresponding courses at BCB. Detailed information will soon become available on KIMEP website. MACTA graduates can apply for 6 out of 9 exemptions.

# ICAEW: CERTIFICATE LEVEL OF ICAEW'S ACA QUALIFICATION

On January 14, the Institute of Chartered Accountants of England and Wales (ICAEW) has re-confirmed its readiness to grant to BACTA graduates exemptions from 6 out 15 exam modules of ICAEW's ACA Qualification, which corresponds to the Qualification's Certificate level.

# **BCB STRENGTHENS COLLABORATION WITH LOCAL UNIVERSITIES**



On January 22, BCB delegation paid a visit to Kazakh-German University (DKU) in Almaty to discuss possibilities for further collaboration in teaching, research and other areas. The delegation was received by the DKU Rector, Dr. Laszlo Ungvari, DKU Advisor to the Rector, Dr. Mereke Tankibayeva, and Dr. Bulat Khusainov, academician of the Kazakhstan National Academy of Natural Sciences. During the visit, the parties agreed that DKU will participate in KIMEP International Research Conference in April 2020 and that the Universities will collaborate on joint research projects. Further, it was decided to start analyzing the possibility to organize dual degree programs at undergraduate level in areas of logistics and chain management.

The previous negotiations with the **Kazakh National University named after Al-Farabi** during 2019 were crowned in January by official signing of the Memorandum of Understanding. The parties agreed to collaborate in terms of publications, research, conferences organization, academic and administrative trainings, and many other areas.

On January 29, the BCB received a delegation from the **Suleyman Demirel University (SDU)**, consisting of a Dean of SDU Business School, a Dean of Department of Engineering & Natural Sciences,



a Business School Chair and Quality Assurance specialists. During the visit, the opportunities for academic, research and administrative collaboration were discussed. Both sides agreed to accelerate signing of a refreshed MOU that would specifically mention academic, research and consultancy types of partnership.



Some selected peer reviewed full papers will be published in Special issue of Central Asia Business Journal, issued by KIMEP University.
