# KIMEP TURKIC LANGUAGES SUMMER SCHOOL

**Tuition:**

- 145.090KZT per credit
- One 3 - credit course = 475.270 KZT (approx.900 USD)

Students can take one three-credit course in Chaghatay, Chinese, Kazakh, Russian, Uyghur, with classes taught in an interactive format.

The program also includes workshops, conversation clubs, excursions, and cultural activities, providing an authentic experience of Kazakhstan's history and contemporary life – a true linguistic and cultural immersion in the heart of Eurasia.



# COURSES

## **CHAG1001 Beginning Chaghatay Language (3 credits/5 ECTS)**

**Instructor:** Gulnar E. Yulghun, PhD, Harvard University

*The course includes a survey of Chaghatay literature as well as a discussion of grammar, the writing system, and lexicographical resources; the class meetings will be devoted to both textbook based instruction and (particularly in the second half of the course) the reading of samples from Chaghatay texts drawn from printed sources and manuscript copies.*

## **CHN1301 Beginning Chinese (3 credits, 5 ECTS)**

**Instructor:** Aigerim Ustemirova, MA, KIMEP University

*The course includes a survey of Chaghatay literature as well as a discussion of grammar, the writing system, and lexicographical resources. Offered in cooperation with the Harvard Davis Center for Russian and Eurasian Studies, class meetings are devoted to both textbook-based instruction and, particularly in the second half of the course, the reading and analysis of selected Chaghatay texts drawn from printed sources and manuscript copies.*

## **KAZ1501 Beginning Kazakh (3 credits/5 ECTS)**

**Instructor:** Akmaral Kurmanaliyeva, CSc, KIMEP University

*The course emphasizes all four major communicative skills (speaking, listening, reading, and writing). Students will learn to use simple to*

*moderately complex sentences for communicating in different contextual settings, holding basic conversations, writing short descriptive passages, forming basic dialogues, and comprehending short texts.*

## **RUS1301 Beginning Russian (3 credits, 5 ECTS)**

**Instructor:** Irina Matsko, Russian Linguistics Expert, KIMEP University

*This Beginning Russian course introduces the basic elements of the Russian language to enable students to engage in simple communication and provides a good foundation for further study. Practice is given in the four skills of listening, speaking, reading, and writing. The course focuses on learning basic vocabulary and elementary grammatical structures, as well as writing short compositions and dictations.*

## **UYGH1001 Uyghur Language (3 credits/5 ECTS)**

**Instructor:** Aynur Abish, PhD, KIMEP University

*The course emphasizes all four major communicative skills (speaking, listening, reading, and writing). Students are also introduced to Uyghur culture, history, and religion through readings, screenings, and class discussions. Another aim of the course is to expose students to a variety of topics in Uyghur culture through culture-based language activities so that students not only learn the Uyghur language, but also the culture, history, religion, and sociopolitical backgrounds of its speakers.*
