

SALES ACTIVITIES AT UNIVERSITY PREMISES

PURPOSE

Office of Student Affairs is generally supportive of student organizations acting entrepreneurially and selling goods for activities. However, if a student organization is affiliated with KIMEP University and/or received funding from either KIMEP or KSA, there may be a perception that the sale is for or on behalf of KIMEP University. University regulations generally prohibit or narrowly restrict commercial activities such as use of University properties for commercial purposes or personal financial gain.

DEFINITION

The word "commercial sales," as used in this document, means any sales activity or event involving the transfer of goods or services for consideration.

POLICY

The use of University facilities and/or property for commercial sales activities by student organization/students is prohibited.

COMMERCIAL SALES ACTIVITIES BY STUDENT ORGANIZATIONS

The University regularly leases space to outside, independent vendors to provide services to the KIMEP community. If a student/student organizations want to sell it might be conducted in vendor's territory. In such arrangements, the vendors have

final say regarding student activities on its leased premises, so long as those activities do not compromise KIMEP University.

If a student organization wishes to set up shop on a vendor's property, it is an arrangement between the vendor and the student organization.

If a student organization, independent of KIMEP University or KSA in terms of branding and monetary support, wishes to conduct business on KIMEP property, Student Affairs will no deny such organizations in their ability to be entrepreneurial. Such organizations have to work closely with the Support Service Division and must conform to all University rules and requirements, in additional to any relevant governmental rules and requirements such as business licenses and cash machines.
