

KIMEP University Hall Reservation Guidelines for Students Make your events happen – the right way!

Purpose

These guidelines help students reserve and use KIMEP University spaces such as:

- Lecture Halls
- Great Hall
- Fun Club
- Students' Lounge (Chillka)
- Recreation Area

You can use these venues for internal university activities like meetings, rehearsals, or student-led events – as long as they follow state laws and KIMEP policies and do not include political, religious, or commercial agendas.

Who can reserve

To book a space, you must:

- ✓ Be a full-time KIMEP student
- ✓ Have a clean disciplinary record

✓ Use the venue strictly for KIMEP-related purposes (student organization events, rehearsals, academic projects) Not allowed:

- Booking on behalf of outsiders or companies
- Using space for sales or commercial promotion

Violations may result in disciplinary action as per the Student Code of Non-Academic Conduct.

How to reserve

- 1. Go to the Student Portal \rightarrow Campus Life \rightarrow Hall Reservation \rightarrow Hall Reservation Form
- 2. Submit at least 3 business days before your event. Late requests may be rejected.
- 3. Visit the Student Affairs office to finalize your booking.
- 4. Your reservation is valid only after it's signed by both Student Affairs and Support Services.
- 5. Need tech equipment? Mention this in your form and email lcd@kimep.kz at least 1 week in advance.
- 6. Special setup? Contact the Support Services Division and coordinate with the building commandant at least 1 week before your event.

During event

Respect the space, the people, and the policies. Here's how:

- Follow the Student Code of Non-Academic Conduct
 - Your event must not disrupt academic activities. The use of loud or amplified sound is strictly prohibited in areas near classrooms.
 - Return all furniture to its original setup
 - Clean up after your event
 - End events by 10:00 PM no exceptions
 - Turn off all lights, equipment, and computers
 - Treat university staff with respect
 - You're responsible for any damage or loss

Violations and consequences

Breaking the rules may lead to:

- Suspension or ban from reserving facilities
- Disciplinary probation (which may affect your leadership roles or event participation)
- Financial responsibility for damages
- Other penalties under KIMEP's Student Code of Non-Academic Conduct
- All violations are reviewed case-by-case by the Student Affairs Office.
