STEP 1. APPLY ON-LINE

The applicant portal is available 24/7, 365 days a year.

- If available, upload valid copies of IELTS/TOEFL/Duolingo certificates.
- Digital photo

The digital photo with a resolution of 300 ppi (pixels per inch) with a size of no less than 8 MP (Megapixels) in JPEG format with low compression (high quality).

STEP 2. UPLOAD COPIES OF MAIN DOCUMENTS

The documents should be submitted right after receiving their appropriate authentic documents

- The vocational high school diploma copy with its supplement
- A screenshot with UNT scores and the certificate ITC number should be uploaded and inserted into the Applicant's Portal in the UNT section (the UNT passing scores for admission purposes are set by the Ministry of Education and Science of the RK) in the following cases:
 - If the applicant is not applying to the fast-track program
 - If the applicant is applying to the University's internal scholarships competition

STEP 3. SUBMIT THE VOCATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA WITH A SUPPLEMENT (ORIGINAL) TO KIMEP ADMISSIONS OFFICE – THE DOCUMENT IS BE SUBMITTED UPON READINESS.

*Educational documents issued by foreign educational institutions must have a notarized translation into Kazakh or Russian and undergo the nostrification/recognition process during the first semester of study.

STEP 4. SUBMIT AUTHENTIC MEDICAL DOCUMENTS TO KIMEP MEDICAL CENTER

- Medical Certificate – Form # ф-075/у for Kazakhstani students or its equivalent for foreign students. KIMEP Medical Center may request a notarized translation of the medical certificate equivalent therefore the international students are recommended to undergo a medical examination upon arrival to Almaty.
- The original chest X-ray shot signed and stamped by two doctors (the expiry date of the document should not exceed 6 months).
- Copy of the vaccination record (ф-065/у)

Applicants seeking admission to the LL.B. (Bachelor of Jurisprudence) and B.I.L. (Bachelor of International Law) programs must demonstrate English language proficiency as follows:

Applicants who present an IELTS score of 6.5 or higher, or an equivalent score on another approved international English proficiency examination, shall be granted direct placement into academic courses.

Applicants who present an IELTS score of 5.5 or 6.0, or an approved equivalent, shall be required to undergo a mandatory interview. Based on the outcome of the interview, the applicant may:

- Be admitted to the program with concurrent English language remediation; or
- Be advised to pursue an alternative academic pathway.

STEP 6: LEARN ABOUT THE ADMISSION DECISION AND SIGN THE CONTRACT FOR EDUCATIONAL SERVICES

1. Since e-mailing is an official channel of communication of KIMEP University with the applicants your e-mail indicated in the online application form should be valid at the moment of being admitted as a student.
2. Notification on admission to KIMEP University will be sent to your e-mail as well as placed at the applicants' portal in «Acceptance Package» section.
3. The Contract for Educational Services will also be placed at your applicant's portal in «Acceptance Package» section. Two printed out and signed copies of the Contract should be submitted to the Admissions Office before the end of the period of registration for courses.
