Student AI Conference Competition Rule

Objectives

The KAI Conference 2024's poster competition aims to showcase students' work in AI, and promote understanding of AI. Students' work must have an AI component, but it can be in applied to any chosen field of interest. The submitted work can be software, hardware or a combination of both.

Rules

- The participant must be a high school student.
- One entry maximum per person, with a maximum of 2 participants per poster.
- A0 poster, portrait or landscape layout, using the provided template [insert link?].
- The poster should contain all relevant sections (i.e., name, institution, title, abstract, introduction, objectives, methodologies, results, conclusion, references).
- The poster must be in English.
- The topic must have a clear relationship to AI and it must be the participant's own work.
- A small table will be provided in front of each poster to allow participants to demonstrate their artefact, e.g., running their own implementation of AI on their developed software or hardware on their laptop.
- Posters with references to political parties, religions, or containing unverified information, with offensive nature will not be accepted.
- The participant must be available to answer questions during the poster session of the KAI Conference 2024.
- The participant must register the title of their poster by deadline: November 15, 2024, at 5:00
 PM (17:00 Astana Time). Link for title confirmation:

- Final poster submitted on online portal by deadline: *November 19, 2024, at 8:00 AM (08:00 Astana Time)*. *Link for submission:* Poster Submission

Scoring Criteria

- Originality: the level of novelty in the work, e.g., from reproducing existing work to components which is no one has developed before.
- Technical difficulty: the choice of the tools used and complexity of the application.
- Questions and Answers: how well the participants answer the judges' questions during their demonstration.
- Professionalism: how well the participants present themselves and their work.
- Presentation of the poster: the visualisation and the organisation of the poster itself.

Prizes

- Top 3 prizes (cash 200,000 KZT, 100,000 KZT, 50,000 KZT), Certificate of Excellence, and video interview feature's on KIMEP's Instagram.
- Certificate of Participation to all participants.

Terms and Conditions

- Participants hereby give consent to the duplication and distribution of their submission and the recording during the conference.
- The judges will be appointed by KAI Conference committee, and the judges' decision is final.
- KIMEP reserves the right to cancel, terminate or modify the competition at any point in time.
- It is the participant's responsibility to ensure that their submission is safely received, and the poster has a sufficient resolution for quality printing.
